- FamilyWize prescription discount cards were first made available in Illinois in 2006.
- Average savings of up to 30% or more is realized, with biggest discounts on generics.
- Savings realized 8 out of 10 times over the pharmacies' retail price.
- Card covers ALL FDA approved prescription medicine.
- Can be used at 95% of the pharmacies in the U.S., including all major chains.

- Cards are currently distributed in 98 Illinois counties.
- No applications or fees required.
- No eligibility, income, age or residency restrictions.
- No personal information is collected.
- Card is valid nationwide and can be photocopied for friends, co-workers & employees.
- FamilyWize provides the savings on prescriptions because participating local pharmacies have voluntarily agreed to accept prices for medications that are close to the prices they make available to large insurance companies and employers.
- Distribution of free FamilyWize cards is coordinated by over 800 United Ways nationwide.
